The International Olympic Committee is entitled to special rates at several Lausanne hotels. The enclosed list contains their contact details and rates, and you are kindly requested to contact the establishment of your choice **directly in** order to arrange your own bookings

**Customs**

Since Switzerland is neither part of the EEA (European Economic Area), nor of the EU (European Union) and in order to avoid any customs problems when bringing your collections into the country, we would like to bring to your attention the following points:

**- *If you are participating as a seller or trader***

We strongly urge you to contact a forwarding agent in your region who will make all the necessary arrangements for temporary export from your country and transit to Lausanne

**- *Precious metals***

Importation of precious metals (gold, silver, platinum and alloys thereof) is subject to the "Contrôle des Métaux Précieux" (CMP) (precious metal control office), CH-3003 Bern. It is therefore necessary to provide this office with a comprehensive list of the items to be imported, specifying their value, composition and, where applicable, the hallmark, in order to avoid delays or even an outright refusal to allow their importation into Switzerland

**Currency exchange**

There will be no exchange booth on the Olympic Museum site during the event. We therefore recommend that participants make arrangements to obtain Swiss currency beforehand. Change is possible daily (8.00 am-7.00 pm) at Lausanne railway station
